Bills

• **HB 341/SB 1022 H. Lee Moffitt Cancer Center (Coley/Storms)**

Recognizes the Cancer Center's Statewide Presence and Impact, replaces "Board of Education" with "Board of Governors", clarifies the Institute's Sovereign Immunity, and requires Board of Governor Approval of For-Profit Subsidiary Articles of Incorporation

• **HB 101/SB 838 USF PharmD (McKeel/Fasano)**

Authorizes a doctor of pharmacy degree program at the University of South Florida

• **HB 963 Seaports (Ray)**

Reduces the wait for permitting and site development for maritime industry from 49 months to 12-18 months. Ensures that allocation of funds for seaport development projects are made on a "market-driven" basis rather than a bureaucratic process. And ensures that those businesses are eligible for state economic development incentives offered by OTTED/Enterprise Florida.

Military Affairs PCB

Addresses encroachment/land use issues as they pertain to new construction in the proximity of airfields. Reduces reciprocity barriers for family members on military orders.
